POLICY

Subject: National Championships

Adopted by the Board of Directors: June 12, 1999;

revised April 30, 2000; revised February 7, 2003 reviewed August 15, 2011

- 1) A Canadian National Championship remains, in the first instance, the property of the Canadian Snowsports Association.
- 2) Such a series is considered a multi-discipline National Championship involving two or more member Disciplines.
- Recognizing that the CSA does not at this time have the resources to market National Championships as a whole, as an interim policy, member organizations are released to secure their individual National Championship sponsorships.
- 4) The CSA recognizes the distinction between the concept of a multi-discipline National Championship Series and the individual National Championship competitions of each member organization.
- 5) Should a sponsored National Championship Series be proposed, member organizations will have the option of whether or not to participate.
- 6) The CSA will not charge sanction fees in excess of FIS Calendar fees on the National Championship competitions of individual member organizations.
